



THE ORDER OF NEW KNIGHTHOOD OF OUR LORD AND HIS HOLY MOTHER

OUR LADY ASKS FOR THE PAINTING OF AN IMAGE:
'THE VIRGIN OF THE CROWNS'.

25 August 2011: Feast of St. Louis, King of France.

... I am your *Mother* and the *Mother of the Order of New Knighthood*, and I am the *Abbess of the Oblate Servants of the Precious Blood of the Sacrificed Lamb*. Under these titles, I want each *Knight*, on the occasion of his *Act of Engagement* or his *Act of Confirmation of His Engagement*, to choose Me officially as *Mother*, by making, or renewing, his consecration to My Heart according to the *Act of Consecration of St. Louis-Marie Grignion de Montfort*. And I desire to be honoured in the *Order as Mother of the New Knighthood, Mother of Ireland and all the Nations, and Mother of the Sacrificed Lamb*.

I desire that an image be made of Myself, in which I bear the *Coat of Arms of the Order* on my heart and where My three new titles of Maternity would be displayed. My gown is to be blue like the scapular (royal blue), and my mantle is to be brown as on its other side.

And I will hold the *Crown of the House of Ireland* in my left hand and that of the *House of France* in my right hand. And on my head, the *Crown of the Assumption*. A wide brown leather belt, with a buckle decorated with a *fleur-de-lys*, and a brown *Rosary* hanging from it. On my feet, brown leather sandals. Under my feet, the globe of the earth resplendent with light. Behind me, above my head, the *dove of the Holy Spirit* radiating Light.

Upon my forehead some hair, blonde, shows from under my veil. My eyes are blue. My colour is fair, my cheeks lightly coloured and my lips likewise. I am smiling at my children.

I am beautiful in my *triple maternity of Mother of the Order of New Knighthood, Mother of Ireland and all the Nations, and Mother of the Sacrificed Lamb*. At my feet, on the globe, nestled to my gown, a *Lamb (portant épée) bearing a sword*, as at Knock. It is on the right, under the *Crown of the House of France*. Now let each *House* expose this image, and make me known and honour me.

A-M: Mother, who will paint this image?

I have a daughter who will be able to do this, do not be anxious about this. Let my request be known. Let there even be a competition, and you will choose the image that most closely resembles what you have seen. Daughter, I bless you, as well as my son in Ireland and all my children of the *Order of New Knighthood*.

30 August 2011:

Daughter, this is Mary, your *Mother*, and *Mother of the Order of New Knighthood*. The Lamb is as you depicted it in your quick sketch. It bears a double edged Sword with a pommel in the form of a Cross, which symbolises the *Combat* which the *Order*, which is my *Order*, must undertake, that of the *Woman and the Dragon* (Rev. Ch. 12). ...

A-M: Mother, I am very touched by your desire to be honoured in the *Order* as *Mother of the Order of New Knighthood* through the image (of the 'Virgin of the Crowns') that you have described to me and through the *three titles* you have given. ...

Daughter, it (veneration of the image of the 'Virgin of the Crowns') is the beginning of the mission. You are beginning to become aware of its real significance. You are the instrument of the Divine Plan for the rescue of the Nations and the children of God faithful to the Father. ...

5 September 2011:


